Main takeaway: this page gives the owner a concrete visual update and the manager a sharper operator follow-up list.

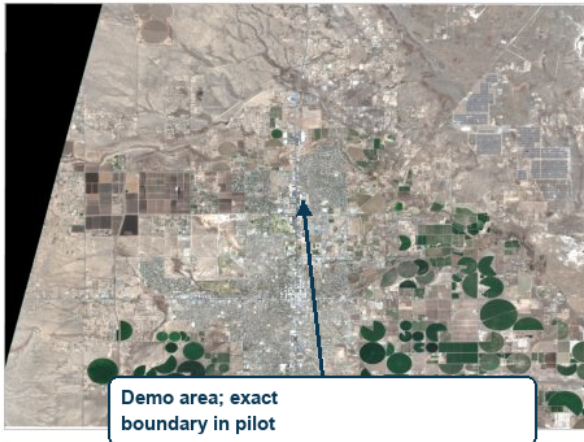

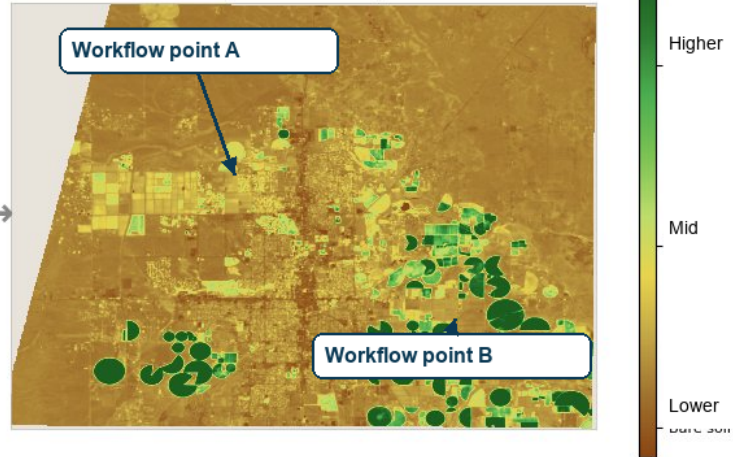

Observed patterns

- Visible variation gives the owner something concrete to review.
- Operator follow-up points separate what is visible from what must be checked locally.
- The page supports communication; final field interpretation stays with the manager/operator.

Questions to check

- Does this match the tenant/operator's reported crop, irrigation, and fieldwork status?
- What short owner-facing note should accompany this visual?
- Which operator follow-up items should be resolved before the next owner call?

How to use this

- Paste into the next monthly, seasonal, or quarterly landowner update.
- Use the owner summary to make the update less vague.
- Use the operator follow-up list before sending final conclusions to the owner.

Owner-report insert includes

- Owner-facing summary ready to paste into an update.
- Operator follow-up items.
- Owner-safe limits: no diagnosis or yield forecast.

Guardrail: Final field interpretation stays with the manager/operator; this is an owner-communication insert.

Limits

Demo sample only. Shows satellite-visible patterns and owner-report questions for further review. Not agronomy advice, crop diagnosis, yield forecast, or field verification.
